
So you are once again requested to look into the issue and bring awareness of the scheme by propagating it display in Notice Board and website of your university/college/ institute.



Sir/Madam,

Please find enclosed herewith copy of letter No. 8-5/2019-SS dated 26.09.2019 received from Joint Secretary, Ministry of Minority Affairs, Government of India, on the subject cited above.

As per the online application status available on NSP portal, it has been observed that only **8695** applications have been received out of **46587** under all three scholarship schemes, as on 27.09.2019, which is very low against the State quota (**46587**) fixed to NCT of Delhi by the Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India for the year 2019-20. Ministry has directed to follow up the matter to speed up the received online applications and gives wide publicity through advertisements in the local and vernacular newspapers and local dailies by using suitable publicity media for better awareness of such applicants so that maximum number of applications could be received against the fresh target.

Therefore, you are once again requested to issue necessary directions to concerned Officers to follow up with schools/institutes under their jurisdiction to speed up the registration and verification of applications process, could be done within the prescribed timeline given by the Ministry of Minority Affairs.

Subject: Implementation of Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit cum Means Scholarship Schemes through National Scholarship Portal (NSP) for 2019-20.

Dear Sir/Madam,

This refers to the slow progress of application registration on National Scholarship Portal (NSP) under Pre-Matric, Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means based scholarship schemes for minorities for year 2019-20 in respect of your State/UT.

2. It has been communicated to your State/UT that the last date of application in case of Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme is 15.10.2019. Similarly, in case of Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Schemes the last date for application is 31.10.2019 for Fresh and Renewal both category.

3. Nevertheless, as per the online application status available on NSP portal, it has been observed that Fresh applications received especially under Pre-Matric Scholarship Scheme is very less (not even 75%) so far against the assigned target of your State/UT(copy enclosed). It is also presumed that around 10% applications will be defected / rejected during the verification process which would further decrease the number of eligible applications. Moreover, in case of Post-Matric and Merit-cum-Means Scholarship Schemes the application registration progress is also not very satisfactory against the Fresh quota of your State/UT under the schemes.

3. Since any further extension in the last date of application would delay the disbursement of scholarships in 2019-20 to the eligible and deserving students, every process of application and verification is to be completed within the stipulated timeline of Scholarship Schemes.

4. It is requested to give one more advertisement in respect of all three Scholarship Schemes in print and other mediums for inviting more applications. It is also advised to explore other modes of publicity in your State/UT for better awareness of such applicants so that maximum number of applications could be received against the Fresh target.

Eligibility

- The applicant should belong to any one form the notified Minority communities' viz. Muslims, Christians, Sikhs, Buddhists, Zoroastrians (Parsis) and Jains.
- The applicant should be pursuing studies in India in Government or Private Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools.
- The course being pursued should be of Minimum one year duration.
- The applicant should have secured 50% marks in the last annual Board/Class examination.
- Income certificate issued by competent authorities of GNCT of Delhi, valid at the time of submission of application.

- Applicants are advised to apply online against any one of the scholarship schemes on the Website of National Scholarship Portal at- www.scholarships.gov.in (a link to the site is also available at www.minorityaffairs.gov.in) or Mobile App- **National Scholarships (NSP)**.
